

The Express Clydesdales of Express Employment Professionals

Serving as ambassadors for Express Employment Professionals, these rare black-and-white Clydesdales weigh between 1,800 and 2,300 lbs. each. Looming over other horse breeds, Clydesdales mature to an average height of 17 to 19 hands, which is about 6 feet from the ground to the horse's shoulder.

The world-renowned Express Clydesdales; owned by Bob Funk, have been competing and touring in North America since 1999 and continue to win numerous competitions, including:

Stoller Family Estate

Located in Oregon's beautiful Willamette Valley, the Stoller Family Estate produces world-class wines and offers genuine hospitality. Bill Stoller, owner and wine aficionado, purchased the nearly 400-acre property from his cousin in 1993, which was originally their father's turkey farm. The winery crafted its inaugural Pinot Noir in 2001. At an elevation between 300 to 650 feet, the volcanic soil and rocky terrain is ideal for making Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

In 2006, Stoller Family Estate became the first Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certified winemaking facility in the United States, earning its Gold level certification. The LEED Green Building Rating System was developed by the U.S. Green Building Council as a voluntary, consensus-based national standard for high-performance, sustainable building. Using traditional, gravity-flow winemaking and energy efficient systems, the winery preserves an old-world purity in the wine making process.

Open daily for visits and tastings, Stoller Family Estate also encourages wine enthusiasts to vacation on the property, which boasts three country homes available for nightly and weekly rates.
